- Walk
- Clap hands
- Throw/kick a small ball
- Run
- Jump

Social Skills

- Begin to share toys
- Begin to take turns
- Make new friends
- Follow one step directions/verbal commands
- Follow classroom rules
- Point to show others something interesting
- Communicate needs and wants to teachers

Art Skills

- Participate in art activities

Music Skills

- Participate in group singing
- Participate in doing hand motions to various songs
